5. **Multi-Purpose Storage Solutions**

- The trailer uses see-through, five-gallon containers that fit between the rungs of the ladder frame. These containers are perfect for segregating and transporting different types of cargo.
- Each container can hold up to five gallons of material, and the entire system can carry a combined weight of 350 pounds. The containers provide easy visual identification of contents.

6. **Compact and Expandable**

- Despite its compact size, the shell of the trailer measures just under 8 feet long, 2 feet wide at the base, and 33 inches at the gunnels. The shells can be stored upright or nested for convenient transport and expanded to provide up to 14 cubic feet of storage for each shell.
- The shells on the ladder frame can also serve as a base to carry larger items, even a 4x8 sheet of material, across the top.

1. **Convertible Sleeping Space**

- The trailer can quickly be transformed into a sleeping area by adding an air mattress inside the clamshell structure. With two inches of foam providing insulation, it's perfect for a comfortable night's rest.
- Add a mosquito net for bug protection, and a tarp to guard against bad weather or collect rainwater for drinking. The design prioritizes comfort while offering practical solutions for extended trips.



2. **Human-Powered or Electric-Assisted Mobility**

- This versatile trailer can be pulled by a light electric vehicle or moved by hand using its lightweight frame. It's designed to accommodate travelers who want to reduce their carbon footprint or use solar power for extended off-the-grid trips.
